

A COVENANT OF TRUST

Adopted by the Ohio District Board of Directors
March 31, 1989

RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of the Ohio District expresses its commitment that politicking, either at District Conventions, or in other activities within and without the Ohio District, shall be of a positive and uplifting nature, as befits those who confess Jesus as Lord; and be it further

RESOLVED, that, with the intent to provide maximum openness within the District for the process of elections, the names and addresses of those who serve on that nominating committee shall be published and given wide dissemination, with an open appeal to all members of the Ohio District to confer with these nominating committee members their concerns, questions for information, and suggestions for nominees; and be it further

RESOLVED, that all nominees for District office or Board membership shall complete an information form, which agree to have their names, addresses and other information on such forms published to all delegates to the Ohio District Convention and that such publication shall be effected prior to the opening date of the Convention; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Ohio District Board of Directors affirms its recognition that the selective publication and circulation of voting lists, and other forms of communication which besmirch the character of any person or call into question either their commitment to the Lord or His church, have no useful purpose other than to divide or faction His people, and be it finally

RESOLVED, that any groups or individuals who desire to make known their intentions to vote for particular candidate(s) may publish such lists, provided that such publication is of documents signed by the names of those responsible for their generation, such signatures affirming that any information contained thereon is accurate insofar as those publishing are able to attest, that any names recommended appear by the expressed approval of those individuals, and that any opinions expressed are solely those of the signatories.
